



IMPACT AT A GLANCE





Dedeaux's second quarter community engagement efforts contributed towards a total of six Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) impact areas - that's a 150% increase in impact compared to the first quarter! Dedeaux's largest impact area was SDG-4 Quality Education. This past quarter, Dedeaux launched their Dedeaux Youth IMPACT Scholarship. For 2023, thus far, the team has contributed approximately \$30,000 towards education through their Dedeaux Youth IMPACT Scholarship and local scholarships throughout the Inland Empire.

The second largest impact area this quarter was SDG-3 Good Health & Well-Being. Dedeaux participated in two local recreational events and provided \$4,000 in financial sponsorships as funding for event programming. For 2023 thus far, Dedeaux has contributed approximately \$13,300 towards good health and well being, and has engaged with Inland Empire communities at 7 community events.

The third largest impact area this quarter was SDG-10 Reduced Inequalities. Dedeaux participated in three Inland Empire events that provided resources to support youth who are disadvantaged, autistic, and at-risk. Additionally, the team donated approximately \$2,500 in this core SDG area as sponsorship funds for special needs event programming. For 2023, thus far, Dedeaux has contributed approximately \$14,000 towards reduced inequalities.

The fourth and fifth largest impact areas were SDGs 1 and 2 No Poverty and Zero Hunger. Dedeaux supported Feeding America Riverside | San Bernardino (FARSB) as a Silver Sponsor at the Million Meals Gala. In collaboration with other FARSB sponsors at the gala, Dedeaux helped raise 700,000 meals for families facing food insecurity in the Inland Empire. For 2023, thus far, Dedeaux has contributed approximately \$2,800 towards no poverty and zero hunger.

The sixth largest impact area was SDG-11 Sustainable Cities and Communities. Dedeaux provided a Pioneer Sponsorship for the City of Riverside Bourns Family Youth Innovation Center's (BFYIC) Aquaponics Garden. Throughout this past quarter, Impact Alliances Group nourished Dedeaux's partnership with the City of Riverside Parks & Recreation and BFYIC by meeting with the Aquaponics committee to collaborate on the garden's rollout. For 2023, thus far, Dedeaux has contributed approximately \$6,000 towards sustainable cities and communities.




CITY OF RIALTO 2023 EGGSTRAVAGANZA














SAN BERNARDINO CENTER OF INDIVIDUAL DEVELOPMENT PROM

CITY OF FONTANA SPECIAL NEEDS RESOURCE & FAMILY FUN FAIR



Collectively, we helped raise 700,000 meals for families facing food insecurity in the Inland Empire (IE).


